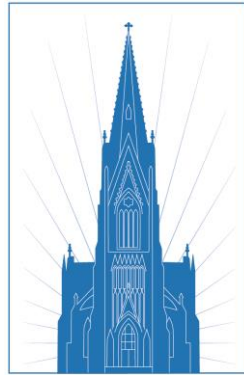

Bulgaria born pianist **Veselin Ninov** is the winner of numerous competitions in USA, Canada, Bulgaria, Russia, Sweden and Turkey. He has studied with the famous mentors Antoaneta Vodenicharova from Bulgaria and Dr. Tamara Poddubnaya from Russia and the USA. His prizes include Grand Prix at the LISMA International Competition in New York, 1st prize at the Stockholm International Competition, 1st prize at the International Competition 'Way to Mastery' in Rostov on Don, 1st prize at the 'Classical Virtuosos of Tomorrow' Competition in Pennsylvania and Grand Prix at the Darrell International Competition in New Hampshire. Mr. Ninov has been a soloist of orchestras, judging international festivals and competitions and has given master classes and solo and chamber music recitals in Merkin Hall, Lincoln Center, Carnegie Hall, Kimmel Center, Steinway Hall and others. His performances have been broadcasted on the BNR Radio and the Bulgarian National Television. Since 2013 he is represented by BV Artists International in New York.

Sunday, December 16th at 4:00 pm

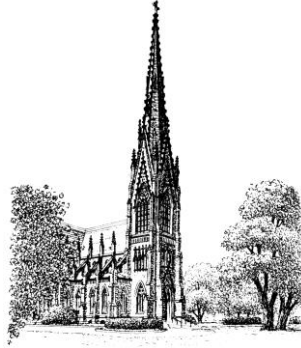
